When combined with a simple standalone controller such as the CRC100, HyperX can be used in conjunction with a barrier or gate to manage access. Tags are provided as lightweight cards and typically placed behind the windscreen to enable the identification of vehicles approaching at speed. The technology operates at a 2.45 Ghz microwave frequency and is relatively insensitive to the environment.

With a high turnover of individuals using the premises, including over 300 permanent employees, Newsquest wanted to improve site security by adopting a flexible solution that restricts and monitors access in and around the building.

Providing a tailored solution based on Nortech's popular Norpass2 Access Management Software, the system currently controls 20 doors situated on 3 floors of building. All readers are linked to CRC220 access controllers, which are then networked to the control system via TCP/IP. The modular nature of the system enables further readers to be added as required.

Day-to-day system administration is carried out over a simple and secure web browser, allowing all authorised operators to instantly update security arrangements and control access to each managed area. The software allows the operator to quickly programme individual cards, allocating each cardholder with access rights consistent with their status and responsibilities. The addition of a new integral badge printing facility, with photo ID feature, allows card issue to be instantaneous.
