Low House Health Care Resource Centre (HCRC) is a state of the art community health centre located in the Duke Street area of St Helens. The centre, run by the Halton & St Helens Primary Care Trust, brings together four GP practices, numerous community facilities including a gym, out-patient services, out-posted hospital services and administrative space into one convenient Town Centre location.



The Challenge

The PCT needed a simple, cost-effective method of preventing unauthorised parking in the car park of the clinic to ensure that there were sufficient spaces available for visitors to the clinic and pharmacy.
